
Thanksgiving Turkeys Layout

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Supplies:

Autumn Cottage Paper
Autumn Cottage Stickers
Autumn Cottage Laser Borders
Autumn Cottage Variety Mats
Autumn Cottage Vellum Paper
12-Inch Trimmer
Custom Cutting System
Circle Patterns
Festive Lightbulb Punch
Flames and Drops Punch
Border Maker System
Mirrored Scallops BMC
Bubbles BMC
Micro-Tip Scissors
Dual-Tip Brown Pen

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a 12" x 2-1/8" strip from Bright White Cardstock. Cut a 12" x 2" strip from wood paper and adhere to the white strip.
- 2. Use the Original Border Maker System with the Mirrored Scallops Border Maker Cartridge to punch two borders from red vellum. Adhere the strips to the top and bottom of the border so only the scallops show.
- 3. Cut leaf paper to 12" x 6" and green sweater paper to 12" x 6". Abut the pieces together with the leaf paper at the top. Center and adhere the border to the seam of the two paper pieces to create a 12" x 12" page.
- 4. Adhere a border embellishment to the border.
- 5. My photo mats are: 6-1/4" x 4-1/4", 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" and 4-1/4" x 4-1/4".

Turkeys:

Create the components first and then layer and adhere the pieces to create the turkeys as shown. Adhere the turkeys to the layout as shown adding a title sticker with Foam Squares.

Turkey Bodies:

 Use the CCS with the medium Circle Pattern and Red Blade on the inside edge to cut two circles from orange paper. Use the Blue Blade on the inside edge to cut one circle from orange vellum. Cut the vellum circle into two 3/4" pieces and use the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to draw tiny feathers. Use the round tip of the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to ink the edges of the pieces. Adhere the vellum pieces to the bottoms of the larger circles.

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Instructions, Continued:

- 2. Use the Festive Light Bulb Punch to punch four bulbs from a dark orange variety mat for the wings.
- 3. Use Micro-Tip Scissors to hand-cut four legs from a red plaid variety mat.
- 4. Use the Flames and Drops Punch to punch two small flames from a gold variety mat for the beaks.
- 5. Use the round tip of the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to ink the edges of the pieces.

Turkey Eyes:

- Use the CCS with the smallest Circle Pattern and Green Blade on the inside edge to cut two circles from orange paper. Use the Blue Blade on the inside edge to cut two circles from Bright White Cardstock.
- 2. Use the Original Border Maker System with the old Bubbles BMC to punch eyeballs from Black Cardstock.
- 3. Use the round tip of the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to ink the edges of the pieces. Layer and adhere the pieces to create eyes as shown.

Headdress:

- 1. Use the Flames and Drops Punch to punch a large flame from red, bright green and gold variety mats for the headdress feathers.
- 2. Cut a 2-1/2" x 1/4" strip from a brown variety mat for the headband.
- 3. Use the round tip of the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to ink the edges of the pieces.

Hat:

- 1. Cut a 2-1/4" x 1-5/8" piece from Black Cardstock. Measure 5/8" over from each of the top corners and mark. Cut from the bottom corners to the measurement marks.
- 2. Cut a 3-1/2" x 1/4" strip from Black Cardstock and adhere to the bottom of the hat.
- 3. Cut a 2-1/2" \times 1/4" strip from Black Cardstock for the belt. Cut a 1/2" \times 1/2" square from a gold variety mat and a 1/8" \times 1/8" square from Black Cardstock for the belt buckle.
- 4. Assemble and adhere the pieces to create the hat. Trim off over-hang.
