



### Tools & Supplies:

12-Inch Trimmer  
Variety of Shape Punches  
Border Maker System (optional)  
Edge Style Border Maker Cartridge (optional)  
Repositionable Tape Runner  
4 Tonal Papers  
Bright White Cardstock  
4 Coordinating Cardstocks  
Coordinating Stickers and/or Embellishments  
Foam Squares

**Notes:** I used the Striped Umbrella, Over the Rainbow, Build-A-Kite, Fresh Flower, Pineapple, and Sea Turtle Punches. I also used the Citrus Slice BMC.

### Instructions:

1. Cut (4) strips from four tonal papers. My strips for my Springtime Soiree Layout are 2-1/4" x 12". My strips for my Sun-Soaked Layout are (1) 2-1/2", (1) 1-3/4" and (2) 2-1/4".
2. Use four Shape Punches to punch pieces from Bright White Cardstock.
3. Create patterns and adhere the punched pieces to the strips. See video for tips.
4. Cut strips from coordinating cardstock that are 1/8" wider than the tonal strips. Layer and adhere the strips to a sheet of Bright White Cardstock.
5. Adhere layered borders embellishments or borders punched with the BMS to the edges. See video for discussion.
6. Cut (2) 3-3/4" x 5-3/4" photo mats from a coordinating cardstock.
7. Adhere photo mats and stickers and/or embellishments using Foam Squares for the stickers/embellishments.
