12-Inch Trimmer

Variety of Shape Punches

Border Maker System (optional)

Edge Style Border Maker Cartridge (optional)

Repositionable Tape Runner

4 Tonal Papers

Bright White Cardstock

4 Coordinating Cardstocks

Coordinating Stickers and/or Embellishments Foam Squares

Notes: I used the Striped Umbrella, Over the Rainbow, Build-A-Kite, Fresh Flower, Pineapple, and Sea Turtle Punches. I also used the Citrus Slice BMC.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut (4) strips from four tonal papers. My strips for my Springtime Soiree Layout are 2-1/4" x 12". My strips for my Sun-Soaked Layout are (1) 2-1/2", (1) 1-3/4" and (2) 2-1/4".
- 2. Use four Shape Punches to punch pieces from Bright White Cardstock.
- 3. Create patterns and adhere the punched pieces to the strips. See video for tips.
- 4. Cut strips from coordinating cardstock that are 1/8" wider than the tonal strips. Layer and adhere the strips to a sheet of Bright White Cardstock.
- 5. Adhere layered borders embellishments or borders punched with the BMS to the edges. See video for discussion.
- 6. Cut (2) 3-3/4" x 5-3/4" photo mats from a coordinating cardstock.
- Adhere photo mats and stickers and/or embellishments using Foam Squares for the stickers/embellishments.
