Tools & Supplies:


12-Inch Trimmer
Shape Punch
Repositionable Tape Runner
5 Tonal Papers
Bright White Cardstock
Coordinating Cardstock
Coordinating Stickers and/or Embellishments
Foam Sauares

Notes: I used Spring Soiree Paper and the Mandevilla Flower Punch for my first layout and Sun-Soaked Paper and the Embossed Blossoms Punch for my second layout. I used Floral Essentials Embellishments and This Life Word Embellishments on both pages.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut (5) 2" strips from five different tonal papers.
- 2. Cut an angle off of the top edge of each strip by placing the top edge of the strip on the 45 degree angle on the 12-Inch Trimmer and the top right corner of the strip on the dashed cutting line of the Trimmer. See video.
- 3. Trim off the flat ends of the strips to get strips that measure: 11", 8-7/8", 6-7/8", 4-7/8" and 2-7/8".
- 4. Space and adhere the strips to a sheet of Bright White Cardstock as shown.
- 5. Cut (2) 3-3/4" x 5-3/4" photo mats from coordinating cardstock, and adhere to the layout as shown.
- 6. Use a Shape Punch to punch shapes from the tonal papers used for the strips. Adhere the shapes to the strips using Foam Squares.
- 7. Adhere Floral Essentials Embellishments and a Word Title with Foam Squares. Add epoxy embellishments as shown.
