Tools & Supplies:

12-Inch Trimmer with Stamping Blade
Bright White Cardstock
Contrasting Cardstock
Designer Paper
Coordinating Stickers and/or Embellishments
Repositionable Tape Runner & Foam Squares

Notes: You can use other Trimmer Blades with this technique.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a 12" x 4-1/4" piece of Bright White Cardstock using the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Stamping Blade. Cut both long ends and a short end of the cardstock with the Stamping Blade.
- 2. Cut the piece into (6) 1-7/8" x 4-1/4" pieces using the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Stamping Blade.
- 3. Cut a 12" x 2-1/2" piece of Bright White Cardstock using the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Stamping Blade. Cut both long ends and a short end of the cardstock with the Stamping Blade.
- 4. Cut the piece into (6) $1-7/8" \times 2-1/2"$ pieces using the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Stamping Blade.
- 5. Cut a piece of designer paper to 12" x 3-7/8". Cut apart into (6) 1-1/2" pieces from the main part of the design on the paper. Keep the pieces in order so you know how they fit back together. Adhere the pieces onto the larger white pieces.
- 6. Cut a piece of designer paper to 12" x 2-1/8". Cut apart into (6) 1-1/2" pieces from the main part of the design on the paper. Keep the pieces in order so you know how they fit back together. Adhere the pieces onto the smaller white pieces.
- 7. Adhere the larger pieces to the top and the smaller pieces to the bottom of a sheet of cardstock.
- 8. Cut (3) 3-3/4" x 4-3/4" photo mats from Bright White Cardstock. Adhere in the middle of the layout.
- 9. Add stickers and embellishments using Foam Squares on some.
