Tools & Supplies:

12-Inch Trimmer with Scoring Blade Border Punch Repositionable Tape Runner Double-Sided Tonal Paper Designer or Tonal Paper Coordinating Cardstock Coordinating Stickers and/or Embellishments

Notes: Lused the Noteworthy Days Collection with the Scalloped Crochet Border Punch and the Sun-Soaked Collection with the Bubble Scallop Border Punch.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a strip of double-sided tonal paper. (Punch a piece of scrap paper to determine the width of the strip. See video for discussion.) My Scalloped Crochet border was 12" x 4-3/4". My Bubble Scallop border was 12" x 4".
- 2. Punch both long ends of the strip with the Border Punch.
- 3. Use the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Scoring Blade to score a line above the border on the bottom of the strip or below the border on the top. Fold up or fold down on the score line and adhere.
- 4. Adhere the border to the top of a piece of designer or tonal paper with the folded end either at the top or bottom.
- 5. Crop and mat photos to fit.
- 6. Add stickers and embellishments using Foam Squares for some.
