- 2 Sheets Caramel Cardstock
- 2 Sheets Bright White Cardstock
- 1 Sheet Kelly Green Cardstock

12-Inch Trimmer

Pinking Blade

Custom Cutting System with Circle Patterns

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a 1" hollow frame from a sheet of Red Cardstock.
- 2. Use the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Pinking Blade to cut Bright White Cardstock to 11-1/2" x 11-1/2". Adhere to the center of the hollow frame.
- 3. Use the Custom Cutting System with the largest circle pattern from the Circle Cutting Patterns and the Blue Blade on the inside edge to cut (2) circles from Caramel Cardstock and (2) circles from Bright White Cardstock.
- 4. Use the Custom Cutting System with the smallest circle pattern from the Circle Cutting Patterns and the Green Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from Caramel Cardstock make sure to position the cutting pattern some distance from the edges of the cardstock. Center the largest circle pattern over the hollow circle and use the Blue Blade on the inside edge to cut a hollow
 - donut shape.
- 5. Use the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Pinking Blade to cut (3) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" squares from Red Cardstock and (3) 4" x 4" squares from Caramel Cardstock. Adhere the caramel mats to the red mats.
- 6. Use the 12-Inch Trimmer with the Pinking Blade to cut a ½" x 12" strip from Red Cardstock.

Instructions, Continued:







Decorate the Sweet Treats:

- 7a. Freehand draw frosting patterns on the two Bright White circles, cut out with Micro-Tip Scissors and adhere to the Caramel Cardstock circles as shown.
- 7b. Cut about ½" from an edge of one Bright White Cardstock circle to create a small cap. Adhere to the top of one Caramel Cardstock circle.
- 7c. Use the Original Border Maker System and the Double Rick Rack BMC to punch border pieces from Bright White Cardstock. Adhere as shown.
- 7d. Use the CCS with the Blue Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from Black Cardsock. Cut the circle in half. Use the BMS with the Bubbles BMC to punch small circles from Pink Cardstock. Adhere a larger circle on the mouth pieces and trim as shown.
- 7e. For eyes, holly berries, and buttons, use the BMS with the Bubbles BMC to punch small circles from Black, White and Red Cardstock, layer and adhere as shown.
- 7f. For the cheeks, use the BMS with the Scallop Hearts BMC to punch hearts from pink cardstock. Adhere as shown.
- 7g. Freehand draw and cut holly leaves from Kelly Green Cardstock. Adhere as shown.
- 7h. Use the Dual-Tip Black Pen and the White Gelly Rolly Pen to add faux stitching to the pieces as shown.

Complete Layout:

- 8. Position and adhere the photo mats, the red strip and the sweet treats on layout as shown. Use Foam Squares to adhere the sweet treats.
- 9. Add titles with Black Script ABC/123 Letter Stickers. (Substitute with other font stickers.)
- 10. Use the Holly Punch to punch two holly pieces from Kelly Green Cardstock. Use the BMS with the Bubbles BMC to punch holly berry circles from Red Cardstock. Adhere as shown with Foam Squares.
- 11. Use the Black Dual-Tip Pen and White Jelly Roll Pen to add faux stitching as shown.
