



### Tools & Supplies:

12-Inch Trimmer  
Pencil & All-Purpose Scissors  
Pure Brown Dual-Tip Pen  
Repositionable Tape Runner  
Foam Squares  
Designer & Tonal Paper  
Bright White Cardstock  
Stickers

**Notes:** I used the Noteworthy Days Collection with additional stickers from Noteworthy Days Simple Page Kits and Advisor Exclusive Mini Stickers. You may use any collection and any combination of stickers. This is a great way to use leftover stickers. You can also use mini punches to add extra shapes.

### Instructions:

1. Cut a 12" x 1/2" strip and a 12" x 1-1/4" strip from plaid paper. Adhere the smaller strip about 1/4" from the top edge of blue striped background paper and the larger strip about 3/4" from bottom edge of background paper.
2. Cut a large heart shape from Bright White Cardstock. See video for tips on how to create your own large heart template. Use Pure Brown Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching around the edge of the heart shape. Center and adhere the heart to the layout.
3. Cut (2) 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" photo mats from brown tonal paper. Cut (2) 3-1/4" x 5-1/4" photos mats from Bright White Paper if desired. Layer and adhere mats as shown.
4. Fill the heart space with stickers. Layer the stickers to create small clusters. Use Foam Squares on some of the stickers.
