



### Tools & Supplies:

NSD 2026 Project Bundle  
Bright White Cardstock  
12-Inch Trimmer  
Custom Cutting System & Circle Patterns  
Spring Blooms Build-A-Punch  
Hand-held Hole Punch  
Piece by Piece Mini Trio Punch with small circle  
Micro-Tip Scissors  
13" x 13" Cutting Mat & Pencil  
Rich Cocoa Ink Pad & Brown Dual-Tip Pen  
Repositionable Tape Runner & Foam Squares

**Note:** You may substitute with other small flower and small circle punches and any papers.

**Please Note:** If you will be joining me for my Virtual NSD Workshop, please wait to create this layout during the event. You will need to create it in sequential order with the other layouts, so you'll have the correct amount of paper pieces to complete ALL of the layouts.

### Instructions:

1. Use the CCS with the largest Circle Pattern and Red Blade on the outside edge to cut a circle from yellow chicken wire paper and two circles from the sunflower/butterfly paper.
2. Center the circles on the 13" x 13" Cutting Mat and make small marks at the 30 degree lines and 90 degree line on the bottom.
3. Cut from the 90 degree line to each of the 30 degree lines to create wedges.
4. Use the Rich Cocoa Ink Pad to ink the edges of the wedges. Use the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitch lines to the wedges.
5. Cut a 4-1/4" x 10" strip from brown dot paper. Ink the edges with Rich Cocoa Ink Pad.
6. Arrange and adhere the pieces as shown on a sheet of Bright White Cardstock.
7. Cut a border sticker to 10" in length and adhere to the right side of the brown dot piece.
8. Use Micro-Tip Scissors to fussy cut the "Just be Happy" title from a variety mat. Also fussy cut out the large butterfly from a variety mat.
9. Use the Spring Blooms Build-A-Punch to punch flowers from Canary Cardstock and yellow check paper. Punch leaves from leftover variety mat pieces. Use the Hand-held Hole Punch and the Piece by Piece Mini Trio Punch to punch small circles from Caramel Cardstock. Use the Rich Cocoa Ink Pad to ink the edges of the pieces, and use the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitch lines to the flowers. Layer and use Foam Squares to adhere the flowers and leaves as shown. See video.
10. Adhere additional embellishments as shown.
11. Use the Brown Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitch lines around the perimeter of the page.
