



Tools & Supplies:

1 Sheet Double-Sided Designer Paper
2 Contrasting Cardstock
1 Coordinating Cardstock
12-Inch Trimmer
Custom Cutting System
Zigzag/Peak Border Cutting Tool
Circle Cutting Patterns
Repositionable Tape Runner
Foam Squares

Notes: For my first layout, I used the Spring Equinox Collection and Baby Blue and Songbird Blue Cardstock. For my second layout, I used the Birthday Bash Collection and Bright White and Dark Sea Green Cardstock. You can use any collection and any Border Cutting Tool.

Instructions:

1. Cut a sheet of double-sided designer paper to 11-1/4" x 12" by cutting off 3/4" from one side.
2. Place the paper so it is lined up with the top, bottom and left lines on the 13" x 13" Cutting Mat. Place the Peak Border Cutting Tool with the Peak pointing to the right and the right feet at 1-1/4" on the Cutting Mat. Use the Red Blade to cut a strip. Place the strip to the left on your table.
3. Move the paper so it's lined up with the top, bottom and right lines on the 13" x 13" Cutting Mat. Place the Peak Border Cutting Tool with the Peak pointing to the left and the right feet at 1-1/4". Use the Red Blade to cut a strip. Place the strip to the right on your table.
4. Cut off a 1" strip from each side of the remaining paper. Putting the left piece on the left of your table and the right piece on the right of your table.
5. Place the paper so it is lined up with the top, bottom and left lines on the 13" x 13" Cutting Mat. Place the Zigzag Border Cutting Tool with the Zigzags pointing to the right and the right feet at 1-1/2" on the Cutting Mat. Use the Red Blade to cut a strip. Place the strip to the left on your table.
6. Move the paper so it's lined up with the top, bottom and right lines on the 13" x 13" Cutting Mat. Place the Zigzag Border Cutting Tool with the Peak pointing to the left and the right feet at 1-1/2". Use the Red Blade to cut a strip. Place the strip to the right on your table.
7. Cut off 1/8" from the tops and bottoms of each strip keeping your left and right strips separate.
8. Center and adhere the large piece on a sheet of contrasting cardstock 1/8" from the top and bottom of the cardstock. Use the measurements on the Cutting Mat to center the piece.
9. Adhere the left edge piece to the left edge 1/8" from the top and bottom of the cardstock. Repeat with the right edge piece.
10. Flip the zigzag pieces to their backsides and center and adhere those and the remaining peak pieces in the remaining spaces on the cardstock.

Instructions, Continued:

11. Cut a 12" x 4-1/4" strip from the same contrasting cardstock. Adhere to the center of the layout.
12. Adhere two horizontal photos to the cardstock strip.
13. Use the CCS with the medium Circle Pattern and Red Blade on the outside edge to cut a circle from contrasting cardstock. Use the small Circle Pattern and Green Blade on the outside edge to cut a circle from coordinating cardstock. Use the small Circle Pattern and Red Blade on the outside edge to cut a photo. Layer and adhere the circles and photo to the center of the layout.
14. Layer and adhere embellishments and/or stickers as shown using Foam Squares on some.
