



Tools & Supplies:

Designer and Tonal Papers
Bright White Cardstock
Stickers and/or Embellishments
12-Inch Trimmer
Die-Cutting & Embossing Machine
Die-Cutting Alphabet - Block Serif
Dual-Tip Pen
Ink Pad
Repositionable Tape Runner
Foam Squares

Notes: I used the Autumn Abundance Collection. You may substitute with any papers. Please watch video for alphabet substitution ideas.

Instructions:

1. Cut a 1" hollow frame from tonal paper. Cut Bright White Cardstock to 11-1/4" x 11-1/4", ink the edges with an ink pad and adhere to the hollow frame.
2. Cut two 6-1/4" x 4-1/4" photo mats from the leftover tonal paper that was cut out of the frame.
3. Select a title. Measure the corresponding upper case alphabet dies and cut strips from different paper patterns in the same width as the dies. My strips are: A = 15/16" x 12"; U = 1" x 12"; T = 7/8" x 12"; U = 1" x 12"; M = 1-1/4" x 12"; and N = 1" x 12".
4. Run each upper case alphabet die and it's corresponding paper strip through the Die Cutting & Embossing Machine.
5. Trim the remaining pieces of the strips to 10-1/8" in height.
6. Adhere the strips 1-1/4" from the left edge of the layout and flush with the bottom of the layout.
7. Adhere the letters on top of the strips.
8. Use the Die Cutting & Embossing Machine with the lower case alphabet dies to cut a subtitle from Bright White Cardstock.
9. Position and adhere the photo mats, subtitle, stickers and embellishments as shown. Use Foam Squares to adhere the embellishments. Use a Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching as shown.
